WHO

YOU qualify as a dislocated worker if you are any of the following:

INDIVIDUAL TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY LAID OFF AS A CONSEQUENCE OF THE DISASTER DECLARATION (Typhoon Mawar)

DISLOCATED WORKER/DISPLACED HOMEMAKER

- Dislocated Worker is an individual who has been terminated or laid off or has received a notice of termination or layoff from employment.
- Displaced homemaker is an individual who has worked in the home for a number of years and suddenly finds that they are the primary source of household income.

LONG-TERM UNEMPLOYED

- Unemployed at the time of eligibility determination; and
- Has been unemployed for 12 or more non-consecutive weeks over the last 26 weeks; and
- Has made an effort to find a job; or
- Is an incarcerated individual within 6 months of release

OR

- Is underemployed at the time of eligibility determination; and
- Has been unemployed for 12 or more non-consecutive weeks of the last 26 weeks; and
- Has made an effort to find a job with self-sustaining wages/hours.

HOW

There are multiple ways to apply.
